The tournament is scheduled to run from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on both days. Teams must check-in from 9:00 AM to 9:45 AM. Registration forms must be completed and payment received no later than Wednesday, April 21, 2010 for your team to be entered in the tournament. The tournament is limited to 40 teams so register early!

The tournament has been organized to help raise money for the Police Athletic League of Philadelphia (PAL) to enable us to continue serving the 26,000 youths currently in our programs free of charge. All proceeds are to benefit PAL and their various educational and athletic endeavors.

TEAMS

Each team will include 3 or 4 players with one player designated as Team Captain. The Team Captain or their representative will be notified when their game packet is ready to be picked up and where to retrieve it. Packets will be made available at PAL Headquarters on Thursday and Friday during business hours following the registration deadline and at the Lenfest PAL Center before 10:00 AM. All team members must be at least 18 years old to participate.

GAME

Each game will consist of 25-minute time limit or until a team has achieved 16 points. At the conclusion of each game, the team with the leading score will advance to the next round. Losing teams will be entered in a loser's bracket and have another opportunity to advance to a subsequent round. ATTIRE

All participants are required to wear appropriate athletic gear (t-shirts, jerseys, shorts, sweats, sneakers, etc.) and are also required wear a distinct t-shirt or jersey identifying their team. No boots or jeans will be permitted.

REGISTRATION FEES

Team registrations are \$100 that are non-refundable. Available payment options are noted on the registration form. Payment can be made by mail or in person at the Police Athletic League, 2524 E. Gameplay Rules and Regulations

Length of Game:

First team to score "16 Points" or "25" minutes, whichever comes first. All games ending in a tie when time expires will result in an overtime period. During overtime, the team who scores the first 2 points will be the winner. A coin toss will determine who has possession of the ball at the start of overtime.

Start of Game:

Each team must have pre-registered and have a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 players to be eligible to play. All players on the court at the start of their respective contest must be listed on the original registration form. Teams who arrive without at least three pre-registered players from their roster cannot play and will forfeit both the game and registration fee. Teams must be present for all games they are scheduled to play or they will forfeit the game and registration fee.

Game Play:

A coin toss by the court monitor will determine which team receives the first possession.

The ball changes possession after each basket. During play, the ball must be taken back behind the arc when the ball changes possession from one team to the other. Failure to do so will result in a violation and the ball will be given to the opposing team. All balls that are determined to be out-of-bounds during the course of play must then be passed in once play resumes—you cannot dribble the ball in from behind any out-of-bounds lines.

Jump Balls:

Once a jump ball is recognized, the defensive team will be granted possession of the ball.

Scoring:

All baskets made from behind the arc will count as 2 points. All baskets made from inside the arc will count as 1 point. If there is any question by the court monitor as to whether or not both feet were behind the arc, the basket will only count as 1 point.

Disputes:

Disputes that cannot be resolved by the team will be decided by a coin toss.

Free Throws:

Free throws count as 1 point. If fouled in the act of shooting and the basket goes in, the foul will be recorded but no free throw awarded. If the basket is not made, the shooter will be awarded 1 free throw. All free throws are considered dead balls, regardless of whether the player makes or misses the shot. Following completion of the foul shots, the ball will be awarded to the opposing team.

Team Fouls: #1 thru #8

Ball is taken out-of-bounds by the opposing team.

Team Fouls: #9 and above

One (1) free throw will be awarded unless fouled in the act of shooting (see above).

Two (2) free throws will be awarded if fouled behind the arc.

Each individual player may accrue **four (4) personal fouls; players will be disqualified after being charged with their 5th personal foul.**

Conduct:

Flagrant fouls will result in instant disqualification. Any continuous misconduct by a player or players will result in disqualification and removal from the team. Any team that has two (2) players disqualified will be removed from the competition and forfeit the game, the tournament and their registration fee.

Unacceptable behavior includes: **posturing, shoving, hitting, spitting, striking, fighting, foul language and any other behavior of a violent nature. Such conduct will not be tolerated. Players and spectators are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship during the tournament. Violation will result in removal from the premises.**

PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING

POLICE ATHLETIC LEAGUE OF PHILADELPHIA 3on3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT WAIVER / RELEASE OF LIABILITY:

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the PhillyPAL 3on3 BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT, related events and activities (collectively, the "Event"), the undersigned, for himself/herself, his/her personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. Acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that the risk of injury from the activities involved in the Event is significant, including the potential for injury, permanent paralysis and death; and
2. KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume all full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. Willingly agrees to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If however he/she observes any unusual significant hazard during his/her presence or participation, he/she will remove him/herself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and
4. Hereby irrevocably grant to the Police Athletic League of Philadelphia ("PAL") and its respective affiliates, subsidiaries, parent entities, sponsors, licensees, successors and assigns, and those acting with its permission or upon its authority (all of whom are referred to below as "licensed parties") the absolute, perpetual, and unrestricted right and permission to record, copy, reproduce, adapt, edit, summarize, copyright, photograph, film, license, vend, rent, distribute, televise, publish, exhibit, disseminate, perform and otherwise exploit in any and all markets and media (collectively "use") his/her appearance, name, likeness, voice, documents, participation in the Event, other property, views, performance, efforts, trademark or trade name, biography, artistry, recorded image and voice, as well as all other documents and artifacts provided to PAL by him/her (collectively the "materials").
