ferent things to do for boys and girls. PAL helped me get around other people and it could help you to.

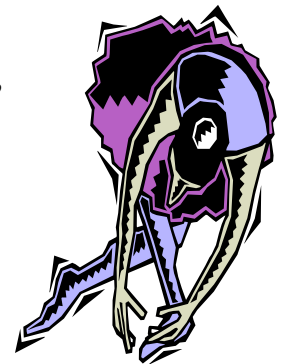
